# WALKING THROUGH TIME

## “ON THE FREDERICK II TRACKS”



A guided tour starting from the medieval town of MELFI, situated at the foot of the extinct volcano Mount Vulture, place of cultivation and production of the famous red wine Aglianico. The town itself is surrounded by a winding Norman city wall, the only one of this kind in Southern Italy. Emerging from the rock face you will discover what is to be considered as one of the most beautiful castles in Italy, featuring by an impressive 10 towers. The spectacular scenery of this medieval village is not to be missed with its splendid cathedral,

Norman walls and rich cultural heritage.

Not far from Melfi there is another symbol of the imperial power and the cultural wealth of the Frederick II of Swabia in Basilicata, that is the Castle of LAGOPESOLE, hunting lodge of the Emperor and his son King Manfredi and second step of our tour.
