

POTENZA WANDERING IN THE CITY CENTRE



The large number of archaeological ruins kept in the impressive Palazzo Loffredo, where the National Archaeological Museum of Basilicata is located, gives evidence of the very ancient and uncertain origins of the town. In spite of many of its medieval buildings lost due to a violent earthquake, the town has still a beautiful city centre worth visiting, such as: the Palazzo del Governo, the recently restored "Stabile" theatre,

some Romanesque churches

with astonishing artworks and frescos, the Guevara tower, the last remnant of an old castle that now hosts art and musical exhibitions.

Not far from the city centre it is possible to admire one of the symbols of the town: the famous Musmeci bridge, an architectural masterpiece that, in 2003, was elected as the "first infrastructural work ready-to-cross".
