SAN FELE'S WATERFALLS "U UATTENIERE"



In the territory of SAN FELE it is possible to follow the route of the Bradano's torrent and so to admire particular altitude jumps made by its stream, or also commonly called as the "waterfalls" of SAN FELE.

They take their name from "U Uattenniere", which is a dialectal transposition of the German word "Walche". A "gualchiera" was a kind of machine set exactly near the falls in order to exploit the water force that, falling on wooden blades, made the

movement of some hammers which, then, hit the raw wool. This processing served to wash, clean and make the wool softer and ready for the next processing. The water force was also used for the working of some water mills, whose ruins can be still observed walking along the route of San Fele's waterfalls. http://www.cascatedisanfele.it
