SASSO DI CASTALDA: “BRIDGE TO THE MOON”



A system of Tibetan bridge (simple suspension bridges) develops around the suggestive historical center of SASSO DI CASTALDA. The main bridge, named “Bridge to the Moon”, is nearly 1,000 feet long and dangles almost 400 feet above the creek below.

It takes at least a half hour to cross the bridge, and it is not certainly for the faint of heart. Glancing down at the gaps between the steel steps reveals nothing but empty space that stretches down to the trees and the stream far below. The journey is worth any brief bouts of altitude-induced fear, though. At the end you can experience the

glass suspended sky-walk boasting panoramic views and

spectacular vistas of the historic village SASSO DI CASTALDA.

The name of the bridge honors Rocco Petrone, a mechanical engineer and son of an emigrants coming from this little village. Petrone was the director of launch operations at NASA’s Kennedy Space Center during the late 1960s and was also a director of the Apollo program, helping launch the first astronauts to land on the Moon. So that this exciting attraction can be considered also as a fitting tribute to the head of the lunar experience.
