EDUCATIONAL GOALS AND EXPECTED LEARNING OUTCOMES

The course of forestry legislation aims to offer a deepened exposition about forestry law branches. After an introduction about principles of Italian and international legislation and about Italian forestry law history, it will analyse international, EU and Italian forestry legislation, supporting a practical approach.

Forestry argument is ever more multifunctional, so its legislation is ever more articulate. The course aims to offer to students coordinates to act in working world with competence and self-confidence about forestry legislation.

SYLLABUS

Lessons I (1 ETCS): General aspects, principles and sources of Italian and international law; historical notes about forestry legislation, above all about Italian pre-monarchic states and Italian monarchic state.

Lessons II (1 ETCS): international and EU legislation: more important international conventions and EU laws.

Lessons III (1 ETCS): The transfer of skills in the forestry sector by the state to the regions, central and territorial organization, the incorporation of Corpo forestale dello Stato; Italian specific legislation: forestry planning at different levels, the PQSF 2008.

Lessons IV (1 ETCS): the forestry asset as protection asset and landscape asset: hydrogeological restriction and Urban code

Lessons V (1 ETCS): the forestry asset as naturalistic asset: protected areas law, monumental trees protection

Lessons VI (1 ETCS): CITES, FLEGT, EUTR law, forestry national inventory, Co.NE.CO.FOR

TEACHING METHODS
